Extensive quality testing. Before the water reaches your tap, it is sampled and tested along every step of the water's journey to you. Testing begins with the groundwater itself, which is checked at the source wells, and again after disinfection. Up to 2,000 or more tests are performed annually to ensure your water meets quality standards.

Our full-time staff of water quality professionals ensure your tap water meets or exceeds all Federal & State drinking water health standards.

State certified operators. Our highly certified drinking water professionals are on the job daily to ensure that your water meets quality standards.

Our crews work around the clock to ensure you always receive safe, reliable, high-quality water. They are supported by:

- 11.29 million gallons of storage in tanks to meet urgent needs at all times.
- Automated, remote monitoring and control systems for 24/7 detection.
- Redundant water control mechanisms.

Independent, state-certified laboratories conduct all the District's testing.

These test results are automatically reported to the State, where they are confirmed and tracked.

Disinfection for quality. Small amounts of chlorine provide protection against potential disease-causing organisms.

YOUR WATER MEETS ALL STANDARDS

Learn more by reviewing your annual Consumer Confidence Report on Water Quality. Each year, Marina Coast Water District is proud to present its annual comprehensive report on water quality. It provides detailed information about where your water comes from, what it contains, and how it compares to drinking water standards.

The District follows strict testing requirements set by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the State of California Water Resources Control Board, which oversees the District's compliance with state and federal drinking water standards.

The District's water quality testing is extremely accurate. We test for over 200 substances. Depending on the substance, we can detect as little as 1 drop in 500 billion drops of water, about equal to:
